



Memorial of Blowing of Trumpets

Memorial: something that is intended to remind people of somebody who has died or an event in which people died, e.g. a statue, speech, or ceremony

Trumpets: The trumpet let you know something is about happen or someone is coming

Lev 23:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

Lev 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.

Lev 23:3 Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day is the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work therein: it is the sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings.

Lev 23:4 These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.

Lev 23:23 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

Lev 23:24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of

blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

Exodus 19

Exo 19:10 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Go unto the people, and sanctify them** to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes,

Exo 19:11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day **the LORD will come down** in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.

Exo 19:16 And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the **voice of the trumpet exceeding loud**; so that all the people that *was* in the camp trembled.

Exo 19:17 And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with God; and they stood at the nether part of the mount.

Exo 19:18 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

Exo 19:19 And when the **voice of the trumpet sounded long**, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and God answered him by a voice.

Joshua 6

Jos 6:1 Now Jericho was straitly shut up because of the children of Israel: none went out, and none came in.

Jos 6:2 And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, *and* the mighty men of valour.

Jos 6:3 And ye shall compass the city, all *ye* men of war, *and* go round about the city once. Thus shalt thou do six days.

Jos 6:4 And **seven priests shall bear before the ark seven**

trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, **and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.**

Jos 6:5 And it shall come to pass, that when they make a **long blast with the ram's horn**, *and* when ye hear the **sound of the trumpet**, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

Revelation chapters 15:1 6;8 8 9 11

Revelation 8:1;13 (the First 4 Trumpets)

Revelation 9:1;6 13;18 (the fifth and sixth Trumpets)

Revelation 11:15;19 (seventh Trumpets)

Matthew 24

Mat 24:29 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

Mat 24:30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Mat 24:31 And he shall send his angels with **a great sound of a trumpet**, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

1 Corinthians

1Co 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

1Co 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the **last trump**: for **the trumpet shall sound**, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1Co 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.

1Co 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

1 Thessalonians

1Th 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive *and* remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with **the trump of God**: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

1Th 4:18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words.
